As you start this time you could think of something special to do each time you come to worship God together. You could light a candle or draw a cross out.

Once you are ready to begin you could say this prayer together:
Lord, As we meet together now we know that you are with us, and with Christians all over the world. We worship you and we love you, Amen.

1 CONVERSATION

As you start this time as a family why don't you talk about some women who have influenced you and/or that you look up to.

Once you have finished chatting you can say this prayer:
Jesus, thank you for the people who are like mothers to us. Help us to also show love to people, just like you do. Amen.

2 SINGING

Now why don't you try singing a song to God together?

4 BIBLE TIME

Find a version of the Bible you like would like to read with each other and read these 2 sections of the Bible together:
Exodus 1:15-20
2 Timothy 1:3-7

5 CONVERSATION

Here are a few questions to talk about the parts of the Bible that you've read:

- Why do you think the Israelite midwives risk so much to save the babies?
- How are they like mothers?
- How does Paul's description of Lois and Eunice make you feel?
- What was the impact they had on Timothy?

6 SINGING

Have another go at singing to God together.

7 PRAYER ACTIVITIES

Here are some creative ways you can pray as a family:

Card Making:

Make a card for your mum, teacher nurse or friend.

While you make the card, pray for them or you could even give them a message you think God might want to say to them.

Mothers Acrostic Prayers:

Write Mother, Mum or the name of someone who has cared for you down the left hand side of some paper. Now try and write a prayer/poem for that person starting each line with the letters going down the page.

Mirroring Love:

Get everyone to find a mirror in the house and look into it, as you do this think of a way you could reflect God's love in your life. Write down a prayer or a name of someone you could reflect God's love to this week.

8 SONG & PRAYER

You could finish by singing one more song together, you could choose your favourite worship song to listen to or sing.

Here is a simple final prayer:

Lord, Thank you for being with us today, and thank you that You will be continue to be with us always, Amen.
